Modern Slavery Act 2015

A requirement to publish a slavery and human trafficking statement

RDO members trading in the UK and with an annual global turnover of over £36 million, should note that Section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 requires businesses to develop a slavery and human trafficking statement each financial year. The requirement for organisations to publish a statement commenced on 29 October 2015.

The statement, which should be public facing, must set out what steps organisations have taken during the financial year to ensure that modern slavery is not occurring in their supply chains and in their own organisation. It is up to organisations how they present information in the statement and how much detail they provide. However, organisations must outline all the steps they have taken.

If an organisation has taken no steps to ensure slavery and human trafficking is not taking place they must still publish a statement stating this to be the case.
